CHAMPION BAY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

PARKING POLICY

This is to be read in conjunction with the Student Vehicle Use Policy.

Rationale:

As we move into 2025, the diversity of vehicle use by members of the Champion Bay Senior High School community will increase. This strategy seeks to confirm areas of community parking and the hours that these areas are available.

The term 'vehicle' will include a moped, motorbike and car.

The term 'school' is in reference to Champion Bay Senior High School.

Aim:

- To provide an orderly and safe environment for the school community.
- To provide a set of conditions that articulates the parking areas and hours of use, adjacent to, and within the school grounds.

Implementation:

- All members of the community are required to adhere to all road rules and drive and park in a safe and responsible manner.
- Students may only park in designated bays within the school grounds, any other bays are designated to staff and other authorised vehicles. Students must park in accordance with local by laws.
- The school takes no responsibility for damage to vehicles whilst on or in the vicinity of the school grounds.
- Any unsafe parking behaviour or breaches of the road rules will be reported to the police.
- Reference should also be made to DoE policy and guidelines.

This policy will be reviewed annually until 2022, after which it will become part of the three year cycle of review.

Refer to the School Parking Map

In 2025, the attached map refers to:

- Area 10 indicates areas designated for bus parking. These areas <u>may not</u> be used by the community during the hours of 07:30-09:30 and 14:30-16:00. <u>This area is for bus use.</u>
- Areas 45 and 46 indicates areas designated for staff parking. These areas are available for use across all hours.
- Areas 49 and 55 indicates areas designated for community parking. Areas adjacent to the front of the
 Administration building on Highbury Street may only be used from 08:30-14:45 and after 16:00. This is to
 avoid the interaction between cars and buses. <a href=Parents/carers may not deliver or collect their student
 before or after school from this point.
- Designated disabled parking requiring ACROD permit are available in areas 45, 46 and 55. These areas are available for use across all hours.
- Area 50 indicates areas designated for student car and moped parking. This area is immediately south of
 the John Willcock Technologies Centre. This area is under CCTV surveillance and is behind security fencing.
 Students will not be able to access this area during the school day unless signed out/in to leave/return
 during the day through the Administration office.
- Area 47 indicates service vehicle access and temporary parking while on delivery.

This policy was last ratified by the Champion Bay Senior High School Board in November 2024.
